

The North Carolina Wildflower Program

The North Carolina Department of Transportation Wildflower Program began in 1985 as an integral part of highway beautification. Currently, there are approximately 3,500 acres of wildflower beds across the state. These wildflower beds are installed and maintained by Roadside Environmental personnel in each of the 14 highway divisions. Both annual and perennial species are planted. Each bed is planted with a mix of species to achieve several flowerings each growing season.


